<u>Primary Care:</u> Physical assessment and evaluation due to reported health history. Evaluation of patient may require the need for referral to specialty clinic care, and the following laboratory testing (Anderson et al., 2009):

- A1C-due to fasting blood glucose of 104 (normal fasting blood glucose target range for an individual without diabetes is 70-100 mg/d)
- BMP- due to fasting blood glucose of 104
- ALT/AST- due to alcohol intake/DUI and elevated liver enzymes
- CAGE/AUDIT-C Questionnaire-due to history of alcohol intake and DUI
- Lipid Panel-due to elevated liver enzymes

Plan to include assessing current medication and renewals as appropriate and consideration of referral to children's developmental/behavioral specialist as appropriate (Cunningham & Jensen, 2011).
- Type 1 Diabetes: Assess history of present illness, preventive screenings, immunization status, previous diagnostics and consultations, previous medications and diet modifications. Assess height, weight, vitals including BP and growth curves. Exam to include HEENT, thyroid, CV, neuro, abdomen. Plan to include renewing current medications, labs, and referral to pediatric endocrine and nutrition clinic as indicated (Alemzadeh & Ali, 2011).
- Chronic constipation: Assess history of present illness, full GI review of systems, previous
 radiologic, laboratory studies or GI consultations, previous medications or therapies trialed.
 Assess height, weight, and growth curves. Exam to include abdominal, external perineum and
 anus, and digital rectal exam. Plan to include dietary and behavioral counseling, consideration of
 medication therapy and referral to pediatric gastroenterology, as appropriate (Rabin, 2012).

Further Assessments needed

<u>Primary Care</u>: Ms. Bevins will need a complete physical/well woman exam with her new Primary Care Manager, to include pelvic exam and pap smear (Kiefer & Chong, 2014). This will include extensive labs and a chest x-ray as she is presently a smoker for an unknown number of years. Because she was formerly homeless, the x-ray is also helpful for determining tuberculosis status, so she will also need a PPD (Kiefer & Chong, 2014). Referrals should be made to behavioral health to evaluate her past history of schizophrenia, and to a diabetes educator to evaluate and assist with her diabetes. Finally, she should be referred for a mammogram and to the Army Wellness Center for help with tobacco cessation. Because of the intricacies of Ms. Bevins care, she may already have or be in need of evaluation for EFMP, so a case manager would be a good start for further evaluation.
